## **DIVING SCORING TIPS**

During diving warm-ups: copy divers names of both teams onto Diving score-sheets by event.

Write names in **pencil** to change easily.

One set of score-sheets for Home team (Official copy) and one set for Away team.

Divers can only compete in one Diving age group in any dual meet.

Age is calculated as of June 15. Same age for dual meets before or after June 15.

**Note**: Coaches may NOT see entries of the opposing team.

**No scratches** or additional entries permitted **after Entry Closing** (15 mins. before start of diving competition.) An entry **change or scratch** must be completed BEFORE the start of the preceding event.

Certain "clerical errors" on the diving entry forms may be corrected during competition.

See "Procedural Errors" in the Diving Rules. Article II, section F

All **DQ's** must be confirmed in person by the Referee to the Chief Scorer. Write "DQ" in Place column. If **no-show**, write "NS".

Write dive scores per event to 2 decimal places for ALL contestants, not just the first 3 places.

Individual event points **5-3-1**. Points are scored by place 1<sup>st</sup> gets 5 pts; 2<sup>nd</sup> gets 3 pts; 3<sup>rd</sup> gets 1 point. Points for **ties** are divided equally: add points for tied place & next place, then average points per diver.

No points sweeps: Max two scores per event per team.

Third place points go to highest placed diver on opposing team (if any) even if placed 4th, 5th, 6th)

Put points **total** for each event under the slanted line \ Put **running total** for all events above slanted line \ Put **total** diving points at top of first swimming score-sheet to continue running totals for meet.

Any **Unofficial Divers** must be clearly noted UnOf on score-sheet. See "Unofficial Entries": Diving Rules Article II, B (6) Max 2 Unofficial divers

End of Diving: Ask Referee if any protests.

**Note**: A protest must be made verbally immediately at time of protested action and MUST be confirmed **in writing** to Diving Referee within **30** minutes after final diving event.

If protest is made: NO FINAL DIVING SCORE SHALL BE ANNOUNCED.

See "Dual Meet Protests", section E of General Sports Rules, Article III (Administrative Procedures).

**Sign** the bottom of score-sheet (& print name legibly)

Ask Diving **Referee to sign** score-sheet (& print name legibly)

Make a copy & pass Diving score-sheet on to Swimming Head Scorer.
